## Access Care Network Australia appoints new board member Hon Judi Moylan AO

The Hon Judi Moylan AO GAICD has been appointed as Board Member for Access Care Network Australia (ACNA).

ACNA provides support to more than 50,000 Australians per year, enabling them to remain independent and in their own homes through unbiased, holistic, wellness based assessments complemented by referral to appropriate organisations for the provision of support services.



The Hon Judi Moylan said she was delighted to join the Access Care Network Australia Board.

“The organisation provides an invaluable service to the community” said Mrs Moylan.

“Enabling people to access the services that assist them to live independently in their own homes and allowing them to remain connected to their local community, is an important part of improving quality of life”.

The first woman to ever be elected to a House of Representatives Seat for the Conservative parties in Western Australia, Mrs Moylan brings a wealth of business, social policy and community affairs experience to the ACNA Board.

Mrs Moylan held the seat of Pearce for the Liberal Party from 1993-2013 and has served as Chair and a Member of many Parliamentary groups and committees, including the Chair of the Parliamentary Diabetes Support Group, Deputy Chair of the Standing Committee on Social Police and Legal Affairs and a member of the Coalition Backbench Economics Committee.

During her time in Parliament, Mrs Moylan has been Shadow Minister for Small Business and Women, Minister for Family Services and Minister for Women.

Prior to entering Federal Parliament, Mrs Moylan was President of the Midland and Districts Chamber of Commerce and awarded Business Person of the Year by the Chamber in 1991, she was a Board Member of Whiteman Park, a Member of the Eastern Region Economic Development Committee and Board Member of the Midland Business Incubator.

In 1996 Mrs. Moylan was awarded the prestigious Kevin Sullivan Memorial Prize by the Real Estate Institute of Western Australia, for individual excellence and achievement.

Mrs. Moylan has received Lifetime Achievement Awards for her work in Diabetes including an Australian Honour (AO) on the Queens Birthday in 2016.
